

As a philosopher, Berkeley was perhaps too imaginative and enthusiastic for the purposes of argumentative discussion; but his intellectual powers, were of great compass, and in all the arts and occupations of common life--whether liberal or mechanic--he was versed far beyond the multitude of ordinary practitioners. But notwithstanding this animation and spirit, his manner was invariably mild, unaffected, and engaging. It is possible that this anecdote about the Burial lesion may be the manufacture of some lover of coincidence.
