The conference attracted 146 submissions from around the world, and the selected papers range in topic from programming language and database issues to analysis and design and reuse, and from experience reports to theoretical contributions. The volume opens with an abstract of the keynote address, 'Intimate computing and the memory prosthesis: a challenge for computer systems research ' by M.G. Lamming, and continues with selected papers organized into parts on framework and reuse, concurrency and distribution, types and subtypes, languages and inheritance, time-dependent behavior, object-oriented analysis and design, and reflection. The volume also contains an invited talk, 'The OSI manager-object model' by C. Ashford, and the position statements from a panel discussion. Englisch.
